

Volunteer Opportunity - Project Transformation

PT's Reading Allstars is a virtual volunteer opportunity – all sessions take place on Zoom. During virtual sessions volunteers listen to participants read, ask questions, and offer strategies for reading help. Volunteers and the PT staff work to help participants maintain or improve their reading level and love of literacy throughout the school year.

Session Options (all times in CST):

- **Tuesdays 4:30p-5:30p** (participants read from 4:30-5:00p and from 5:00-5:30p)
- Thursdays 4:30p-5:30p (participants read from 4:30-5:00p and from 5:00-5:30p)

Participants in Kindergarten-5th grades will join the Zoom meeting in a quiet place ready to read. Project Transformation will email volunteers digital books before the session that correlate with the participant's reading level. Volunteers and participants will read in a Zoom breakout room. Volunteers will share screen so both volunteers and participants can see the provided digital text. Volunteers listen to participants read, offer encouragement and strategies, and ask the provided comprehension questions.

Individuals interested in volunteering will need a laptop or computer, an understanding of Zoom, and the ability to share their screen while volunteering. If you are new to Zoom or screen-sharing, I am happy to host a practice session before you volunteer!
