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Parking Lot Funding Campaign Comes to Successful Close

Our church can celebrate another important milestone with the formal close of fundraising for parking lot reconstruction and expansion. The campaign to obtain pledges for the parking lot project began in 2015 and came to a formal end on February 28, 2017.

When the church initiated the campaign we had a goal of obtaining about 30 pledges that would raise between \$75,000 and \$90,000 toward project costs. The balance of the \$280,000 construction cost would be from funds borrowed from the Texas Methodist Foundation.

However, the church response greatly exceeded all of our initial goals--we received 48 pledges totaling \$134,318.81. Our hope was that if we met 95% of the pledged goal we would minimize borrowing, extend our current loan and keep monthly loan

New Policy on the Use of Photos & Names in Church Publications

A policy has been created and is being publicized to remove any doubt about how photos, videos, and names are used in CPFUMC publications. Our communications and Web team drafted the policy. At our March Church Council meeting, the Church Council discussed and made an extensive markup of the draft, approving the policy as follows:

CPFUMC Policy on the Use of Photos & Names in Church Publications

- 1. Photos, videos and full names of adults may be used in church publications (website, Happenings weekly email publication, Connections newsletter, Facebook, Twitter, etc.), where useful and pertinent, to publicize church events, unless the adult specifically requests an exception.
- 2. Photos, videos and first names only of children may be used in church publications (website, Happenings weekly email publication, Connections newsletter, Facebook, Twitter, etc.), where useful and pertinent, to publicize church events, unless the child's parent or legal guardian specifically requests an exception.
- We will not publish the roster of members contact information online unless it is in a special secure area of our website which requires member login. (Currently this does not exist).
- 4. Exceptions to this policy may be requested on the church website.

Our newsletter, *Connections*, our weekly e-mail report, *Happenings*, and our website, cpfumc.org, are the primary publications affected by this policy. Anyone wishing to request an exception and opt-out of this policy for themselves or their minor children may do so on the church website at https://cpfumc.org/opt-out-declaration/.

discussion, it was decided to also purchase a rolling cart which would allow this TV to be used anywhere the cart could be easily rolled. The rolling cart selected has two shelves to accommodate a DVD player and a VHS cassette player. The rolling cart also has a power strip to connect to the TV and players, so only a single power connection to a wall outlet is required to get things going. This TV on the rolling cart has already been used for a memorial service, the Sunday adult book discussion class, and a recent Child's Haven teachers meeting. Total cost for this AV improvement was \$571.33



The TV cart combo was also paired with an Internet-connected computer for the March Church Council meeting. This allowed the Church Council to group-edit the policy on use of photos and names in church publications and it significantly reduced the amount of paper copying. The colorful cloth bag attached to the TV rolling cart was custom-made by Jane Howard. This bag accommodates all of the remotes and



iPhone/iPad adapters for the AV equipment. Nice job, Jane! She can sew *anything*! In the future we plan to add a very small computer device to this TV cart. Along with a wireless keyboard and mouse, this will allow the TV cart to be a self-contained AV resource with WiFi Internet access. Yeah! We've made it to the 21st century!

The Trustees did not want to leave the youth of our congregation out of the AV improvement activity, so they connected a small form factor computer to the 50-inch

TV added in 2015 in the Youth Room. This computer is a used Dell Optiplex 790 business class machine running





Windows Professional. It is verv similar in size to the computers in the church office. It provides an HDMI connection to the youth room TV. Paired with a wireless kevboard and mouse, this setup

allows full Internet access in the Youth room. This improvement expands on the CPFUMC Internet project begun in 2014 when broadband hardwired and WiFi Internet access were first provided in the Sanctuary building. This computer, wireless keyboard and mouse were donated.

If you are upgrading your home flat panel TV to 4K or a larger size model, you might consider donating your old 55" or greater TV to the church. Please let any of the Trustees know. We are still planning to eventually move the whiteboard and mount a large screen TV on the north wall of the Multi Ministries Building conference room for use during the numerous meetings and classes that take place in that large room.




Especially for Parents
