Cedar Park First United Methodist Church Facility Use Application: COVID-19 Amendment

During the period of the COVID-19 pandemic when additional precautions are in place for places where public gatherings take place, Cedar Park First United Methodist Church has implemented additional required cleaning and reporting procedures for church facilities.

We ask that groups using our facilities participate in these additional cleaning and reporting procedures:

- 1. All furniture used by the group is sprayed and wiped down after the group is finished.
- 2. If used, hallway Bathroom door handles, stall or urinal handles and sinks will be wiped down and sinks sprayed following use.
- 3. Door handles and light switches are wiped down before exit following group use.
- 4. Any surfaces touched (sinks, counters, tables) are wiped down with Clorox wipes following group use.
- 5. Books and paper materials are not considered a high risk for transmission, and do not need additional cleaning. **Can spray with Lysol*
- Group leaders will sign and date the checklist posted in each room used at the end of each group use indicating that the group has complied with the additional cleaning procedures.

Use EPA registered disinfectants like Clorox cleaner with bleach, Lysol and Clorox wipes, *which the church will provide*. When local health authorities have determined that the pandemic health procedures are no longer in effect, the church will notify you that these additional cleaning and reporting procedures are no longer required.

We ask that the church be immediately notified if a group member has tested positive for COVID-19 at any time so that the church may follow CDC guidelines for disinfecting and cleaning following a confirmed case of COVID-19.

We agree to perform these additional cleaning and reporting requirements during the period required.
