If you would like to sing along, the worship bulletin will have all the lyrics. Everyone should be sure to download a worship bulletin.

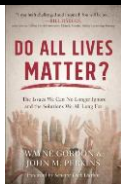

**HOW DO I GET A COVID VACCINE? FROM WESLEY NURSE, PAM CASTLES**

As Texas progresses into Phase 1B in the coming weeks, the state will work with vaccine providers and local partners to ensure that people who are 65 and older or have the medical conditions listed below and who also work in front-line and critical industries have access to the vaccine so they will be protected from COVID-19 while on the job.

**Texas Phase 1B Vaccine Priorities**

- People 65 years of age and older
- People 16 years of age & older with at least one chronic medical condition that puts them at increased risk for severe illness from the virus that causes COVID-19, such as but not limited to:
  - Cancer
  - Chronic kidney disease
  - COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)
  - Heart conditions, such as heart failure, coronary artery disease or cardiomyopathies
  - Solid organ transplantation
  - Obesity and severe obesity (body mass index of 30 kg/m2 or higher)
  - Pregnancy
  - Sickle cell disease
  - Type 2 diabetes mellitus
