I will send out the Zoom invite for this Sunday.



Live Streaming Improvements

Now Available on YouTube and cpfumc.org

Did you know that our Sunday morning live streamed worship services are now available on YouTube and also on the church website? Since we began live streaming on March 22, 2020, our live stream worship services have *only* been available on the church Facebook page. While this is fine for those who have a Facebook account, it is limiting for those who do not and it makes us vulnerable to have all of our live streaming eggs in the Facebook basket. To enlarge our outreach, the live streaming team has expanded the number of places where you can watch and participate in the 10am Sunday morning worship service.

- **YouTube** The church has a <u>YouTube channel</u> which will now be carrying the Sunday morning live stream worship services. YouTube requires no account to view the live streamed service. Our YouTube channel also allows you to comment and submit prayer requests during the live stream.
- **cpfumc.org** The church website now has a <u>page</u> which will display the live stream service and instructions on how to view it. This page is view-only and does not (yet) provide for comments or prayer requests.
- Why not give a try to one of these new live streaming worship service options some Sunday soon? The live stream starts usually around 9:50 am each Sunday morning.

HILL COUNTRY COMMUNITY MINISTRIES (HCCM) THRIFT STORE VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- In January 2020, the United Methodist Women (UMW) organized their mission projects for the year. I was charged with organizing workdays at the Thrift Store. Six of us worked our first assignment on March 7 and then the COVID Pandemic arrived. This event changed many things for the country and our church.
- Since the vaccine is now available, we hope to start up this vital ministry again. We donate food and money to this organization, but they are also need hands-on volunteers. When we volunteered, they asked for a four-hour commitment. We discovered that standing on our feet for four hours was difficult. We might be able to share a shift from 9:00-11:00 a.m. or 12:00–1:00 p.m. for example. They need the most help on Friday and Saturday, so we are hoping to volunteer as a church once or twice a month.
