Six of us worked our first assignment on March 7 and then the COVID Pandemic arrived. This event changed many things for the country and our church.

When we volunteered, they asked for a four-hour commitment. We discovered that standing on our feet for four hours was difficult. # CHURCH HAPPENINGS

## CONSTRUCTION

We are officially half way through the rest room renovation. The Designated Fund for this work totals \$57,515 thanks to all of you supporting our dream rest room update. Even with the required City changes to get our permit [lower the sewer line three feet - \$1100, toilet upgrade (our tanks held too much water) \$854 and add a mop closet (\$2875)] we will still have about \$400 remaining. This is a great achievement to quote when people ask, "what did you do during the Pandemic of 2020?"

Plumbing work will shift to the kitchen this week. In preparation twelve boxes of dishes were packed out of the upper cupboards on the sink wall. This work falls under Restoration after the storm. This past week the contractor and the insurance adjuster came to agreement on final bottom line. To restore the Sanctuary Building will cost \$65,691. Much of the work will be covered by insurance and we have received a first tranche of money. Final framing and the beginning of sheet rock is expected to start this week.


