It was a grand game of "Stump the Chump" and John passed with flying colors. It didn't matter what questions we asked about "this" versus "that", John listened and gave us options and could rattle off the expense of most items without referring to any worksheets.

We had come to the meeting with a list of 14 items to discuss ranging from the final color of the paint on the walls, to what kind of baseboards in the Sanctuary, to the kitchen water heater, to the electricity in the Nursery, to motion sensor light switches, to storage room flooring at the front on both sides of the choir riser, to can lights in the Narthex and hallway, to the sink and counters in the kitchen, etc. John was able to clarify

all our questions and also give us tips on how to maximize our options through his knowledge of suppliers and their inventories.

Barbara, Sheryl and Jane were tasked with visiting Floor Décor in Austin on Monday to make a final selection on the floor color for the Sanctuary tile and to confirm the style of back splash tile we wanted. Color there will depend on the colors of the available counter top – we need a piece that will cover 20 feet.

We all came away from the meeting thinking visible progress will be made this week. So, stand by with us as we look forward to progress pictures next week to prove this true.


BOOK CLUB STARTING SOON

Based on the events in the life of the author's wife's grandmother, *Gum Moon* (Cantonese for "Golden Gate") is the remarkable coming of age story of a Chinese-American girl, Mei Chun Lai, who is rescued by a young Methodist woman and placed in a Home for abused and trafficked girls. The Home is destroyed in San Francisco's 1906 earthquake and fire, but Chun survives. In an attempt to raise funds to rebuild the Home, Chun and a band of seven other Chinese children embark on a six-month cross-country singing tour and a performance at the White House for President Theodore Roosevelt.
