



Don't Panic: Windows 10 Is Still Good for A While

Microsoft will continue to support Windows 10 through October 14, 2025, so you can keep using Windows 10 for several more years. Microsoft will continue the twice-yearly security and feature updates for Windows 10 throughout its planned lifecycle.
