Throughout the Lenten season, Ukranian Christian women decorate the eggs which will be used in the celebration of Easter. After a short prayer, they begin to color the eggs with traditional symbols – spirals, triangles, suns, doves, trees. The eggs are given away as gifts to the family members and friends. Many Christians see eggs as a sign of Christ's death and resurrection; when the hard, tomb-like shell is cracked open, the Easter colors of bright yellow, and white spill forth. Use these days in Lent to decorate eggs for Easter. Create your own designs with water colors, dyes, or felt-tip markers.

CHURCH FINANCE REPORT

In February the Church operated at a deficit of \$(3,048.38). February contributions were consistent with January, but were below the average monthly budget. Operating expenses were also below budget, but that is primarily due to apportionments. Apportionments are not paid in January and February, but will begin in March and occur each month for the remainder of the year. The Church has net income of \$1,479.95 YTD in 2025. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
