CHURCH FINANCE REPORT

In April, the Church had an operating loss of -\$1,670.11. Contributions were down from the YTD high in March. Pledged contributions were on budget, but unpledged contributions were below budget. However, income was aided by the tithe from A Child's Haven. Overall expenses were consistent with the budget. The Church has net income of \$6,221.73 YTD in 2025. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
