## **Church Finance Report**

In June, the Church had an operating loss of -\$4,928.80. Contributions were up from May, but still below the average of the first five months of the year. Pledged contributions were down -11% from the YTD average in 2025. There is seasonality during summer months. Other Income was also lower in June. Overall expenses were in line with the YTD average in June. The Church has a net loss of -\$7,644.51 YTD in 2025. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.

#### VISA POLICY CHANGE AFFECTING STUDENT ACCESS AT LYDIA PATTERSON INSTITUTE

Due to the recent changes in U.S. visa policy, some of the students attending the United Methodist-affiliated high school Lydia Patterson Institute (LPI) in El Paso, Texas—especially those living in Ciudad Juárez—are being affected. New rules require all F-1 student visa applicants, both new and returning, to undergo enhanced screening. This includes public access to social media, documentation of online activity, and broad reviews of "hostile attitudes"—a term that remains undefined and open to wide interpretation.

These requirements are slowing the process and placing LPI's students from underserved communities at a disadvantage. Priority is being given to students at large universities, not schools like LPI, where 40% of the students are international and many face financial, political, and logistical barriers.

In response, LPI is preparing to offer hybrid learning this fall—with some students attending in person, and others learning remotely from across the border. Whether they are in El Paso or Juárez, the school's commitment is the same: the students will continue learning, and LPI will continue teaching, supporting, and offering scholarships.

But the school needs your help to make this possible. Here are the urgent needs:

### How to Take a Picture for the Church Slide Show

#### With your Apple iPhone

Members are encouraged to take photos of church ministry events for the Sunday morning CPFUMC Church Slide Show. This is the slide show that loops during gathering time before the worship service begins and between services on Sunday morning. It also plays constantly on our church website's <a href="Find Out What's Happening">Find Out What's Happening</a> page and on the screen in the church Narthex (aka Lobby) on Sunday mornings. Almost every member now has a smartphone of some sort and these modern smartphones all have cameras, so it is relatively convenient for you to document some aspect of our church ministry and share it with the entire congregation, right? Following are some lessons to help you along.

#### Lesson 3 – Transfer Your Cool 16:9 Landscape Photo to the Church Slide Show

At this point you now have your cool landscape Church Slide Show photos on your iPhone. The question now is how do I get them into the Church Slide Show? The Church Slide Show is an online Google Slide Show. There are a number of ways to send your photos to the Church Slide Show. They are listed below in order of preference:

- 1. Email them to cpfumcslideshow@gmail.com (preferred!  $\circ$ ) See **Note**: below.
- 2. Download the photo files to your computer, make them into a ZIP file and then send the ZIP file as an attachment via your Gmail account to <a href="mailto:cpfumcslideshow@gmail.com">cpfumcslideshow@gmail.com</a>. Gmail will automatically make the attachment into a Google Drive link which can then be downloaded. Be sure to give View access permission to Anyone with the link.
- 3. Copy the photos to your Google drive, share them with View access permission to **Anyone with the link** and share the Google Drive link to Neil Howard.
- 4. Put them on a flash drive and bring them to church. Give them Neil Howard or one of our pastors Peter or Suzette. See **Downloading photos from your iPhone** (below) to get the photos off your iPhone.
- 5. Post them directly into the slide show yourself (if you have edit access to the Church Slide Show). Contact Neil Howard first if you want to do this.

#### Note:

Gmail on an iPhone has a 25MB attachment limit for each email. The photos you have likely range in sizes from 1-5 MB each, so if you have a lot of photos, you will have to break them up into batches and send more than one email to <a href="mailto:cpfumcslideshow@gmail.com">cpfumcslideshow@gmail.com</a>. You may want to use Option 2 in this case. But if you do not have a Gmail account, use Option 4.
