Finance Report

In October, the Church had an operating gain of \$6,618. This includes \$8,861 of Pumpkin Patch revenue. However, the expense of \$6,286 for the pumpkins was not paid until November. Even when adjusting for the timing mismatch, the Church had a small gain of \$332 in October. This was an improvement after six consecutive months of deficits. Pledged contributions improved by almost \$2,500 in October. An additional one-time contribution of close to \$5,100 was received in November. Operating expenses were effectively even with prior months and consistent with the average month in 2025. There were no items that stood out. The Church has a net loss of -\$14,348 YTD in 2025. If we adjust for Pumpkin Patch expense and the one-time contribution, both recorded in November, the YTD loss is -\$15,546. This is an improvement from prior months. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
