Setup to Display PTZ Cameras on Front & Rear Screens

- 1. STEP 1: Unplug the Camera 3 INPUT from the back of the ATEM Mini Extreme video switch.
- 2. Unplug the **HDMI INPUT** (SANCTAV4) from OREI 1x4 Splitter INPUT and connect it to an **HDMI Coupler** which can be found in the top-drawer tray of the Sound Booth file cabinet.
- 3. Using **an additional HDMI cable** about 3 ft long (available in the filing cabinet lowest drawer), connect the other end of the HDMI Coupler to the Camera 3 INPUT (that you just unplugged) on the ATEM Mini Extreme switch.
- 4. **STEP 2:** Disconnect the HDMI cable running from the Avedio Link HDMI Splitter to the Camera Operator Monitor, leaving the HDMI-VGA Extender connected to the Camera Operator Monitor.
- 5. Connect the Avedio Link HDMI Splitter output cable that you just unplugged above into the HDMI INPUT on the OREI 1x4 Splitter.
- 6. **STEP 3:** Connect OREI 1x4 Splitter OUTPUT 3 HDMI cable to the HDMI-VGA Extender which you left connected to the Camera Operator's monitor.

Operation

Use the **VIDEO OUT** buttons on the ATEM Mini Extreme to select Program, Preview or 1, 2, 3 buttons to project a specific camera number onto the front and rear projector screens simultaneously.





When done with this setup, be sure to return the cables to their original positions shown below. i.e.:

- 1. Connect SANCTAV4 video out to the HDMI INPUT on the OREI 1x4 Splitter INPUT as shown below.
- 2. Connect the Avedio Splitter HDMI OUT 1 to the camera Operator's monitor as shown below.
