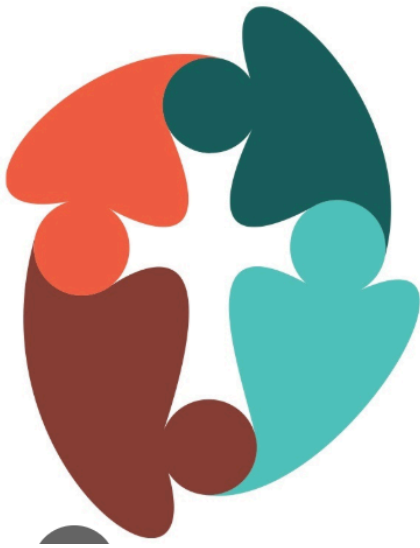

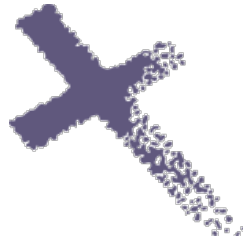

In November, the Church had an operating loss of -\$5,981. The primary driver of the loss was the lowest pledged income of the year. This was likely due to travelling during the Thanksgiving holiday. November of 2024 was also the lowest pledged income of the year. Income was aided by a

generous donation or close to \$5,100 in unpledged income. Pumpkin patch income has been fully reflected. The Pumpkin Patch generated a net \$3,249, a bit more than 2024. Operating expenses were generally consistent with the budget, although building repair and maintenance has been a bit higher. The Church has a net loss of -\$20,328 YTD in 2025. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations. YTD Financial status through November 30, 2025
