Finance Report

In December, the Church had an operating gain of \$9,449. This was due to a significant increase in pledged contributions. Pledged contributions improved by \$10,814 in December. Although this is great

news, seasonality is a driver of the December increase relative to some prior months. Operating expenses were materially lower than November since the prior month included the Pumpkin Patch expense. There were no operating items that stood out. The Church had a net loss of -\$12,527 in 2025. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
