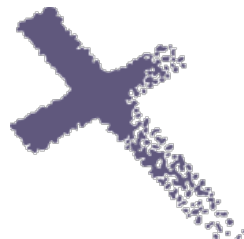
In March, the Church had an operating gain of \$860. This is the second month in a row in which the Church reported a gain. Pledged income was close to budget, but a special offering of close to \$3,100 resulted in a material increase in contribution income. The Church continues to do well on controlling operating expenses in 2026. The Church posted a gain even with the initiation of apportionments that will continue through the remainder of the year. Specific operating expense line items were consistent with budgeted amounts. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
