

Convenient Commands to Determine Dell Computer Hardware Details

Using Command Prompt (CMD), running it in Administrator Mode:

Determine the Dell Service Tag (if the exterior case label is missing or inconvenient to access)

wmic bios get serialnumber

Determine the Disk Drive(s) model, size and status

wmic diskdrive get model,size,status

Display Computer Installed Memory including arrangement size and speed

wmic memorychip get devicelocator, manufacturer, partnumber, capacity, speed, configuredclockspeed, serialnumber

Using Windows 11 System Commands

System Hardware Summary and Model Number

Windows Key+I → System→About

System Storage Drives size, free space and more

Windows Key+I → System→Storage→Advanced storage settings→Storage used on other drives

System Storage Drives manufacturer and model number

Windows Key+I → System→Storage→Advanced storage settings →Disks & volumes

Display (Monitor) Manufacturer and Model Number

Windows Key+I → System→Display→Advanced display
