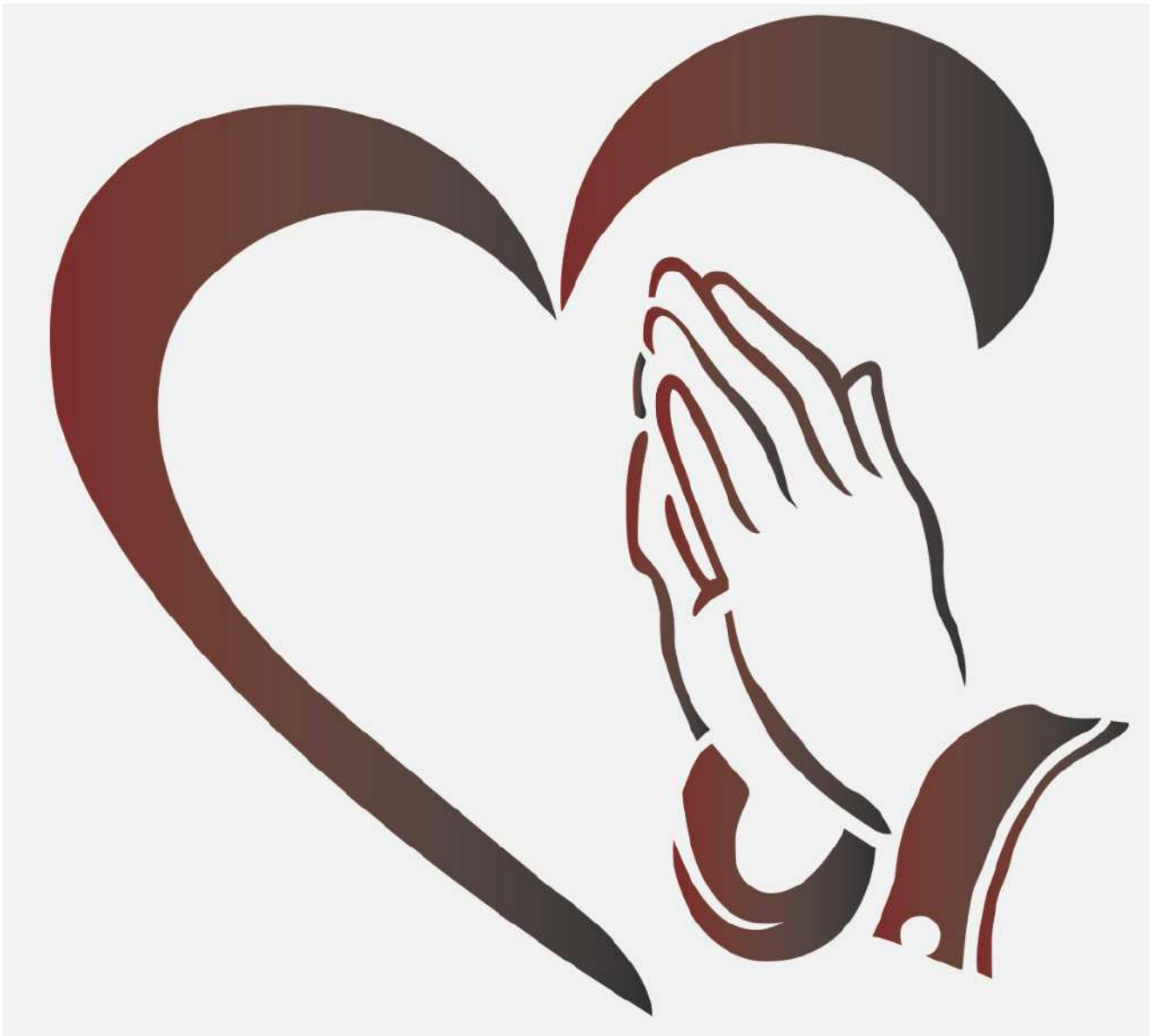

Finance Report

In June, the Church had an operating loss of -\$3,945. Pledged Contributions declined by -\$2,146 in June, while Unpledged Contributions and Other Income were stable. The Church

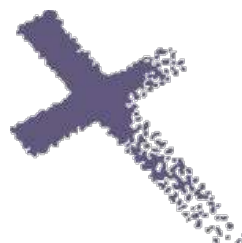
continues to do well on controlling operating expenses as Operating Expense and Mortgage Principal declined by -\$1,417 in the month. Specific operating expense line items were consistent with budgeted amounts. The Church continues to have adequate reserves to meet its financial obligations.
